Hardcore Hart says his main goal in life is to have a beer at every pub on earth... or at least attempt to.

The experienced drunkard carries the title of "World Beer Delegate" at the United Nations of Beer.

The idea for the global booze-up was originally announced back in April and has since gained attention worldwide.

Media and Online manager at Thirsty Swagman, Karen Logan said: "We chose all the destinations because of their reputation for nightlife and choice of pubs and bars.

"Every place we visit offers something totally unique, and no two pubs will ever be the same.

The tour costs 11,900 Australian dollars (just over £5,000) and bookings will be finalised on December 31, 2007.
