Instead, you'll power onto tiny Maria Alm in Austria, where exclusive pubs and the most incredible alpine drinking experience awaits you....

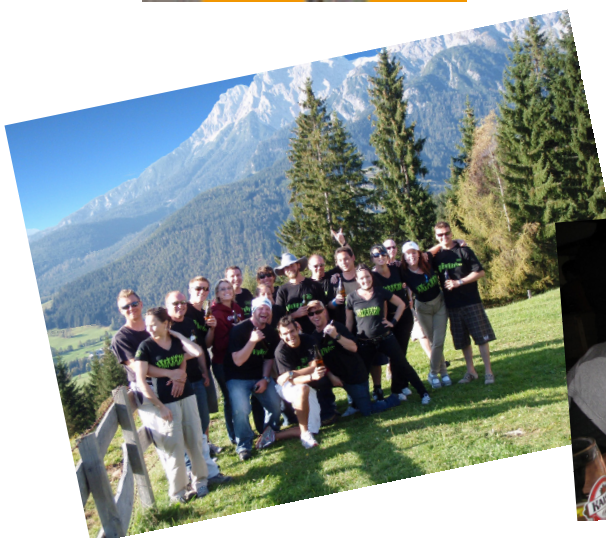
...with traditional alpine bars within staggering distance from your lodge, Maria Alm will prove the highlight of your tour! It's home to the world's hardest and toughest barman (you'll find out when you get there!), and the locals serve up some of the most unique drinks on the planet – incl. vodka shots in chicken soup.

After a weekend-stint in Austria, you'll be heading straight for the pub crawl capital of Europe – Prague, Czech Republic. With a nightlife that is simply unmatched, you'll be hammering your way to traditional underground Czech bars, as well as the Beer Factory, where your own personal beer tap awaits you on every table. With glass in hand you'll be pouring your own and nailing the pints by the litre.

Had enough? Harden' up, because next stop is Bamberg. Boasting the world's highest concentration of breweries per capita, you'll cancel the boring sightseeing and head straight to the bar for an endless selection of incredible watering holes.

Finally, the "World's Longest Bar" awaits you in Düsseldorf, Germany. More than 360 pubs and bars within a single block of streets, serving up the brew to over 100,000 people every weekend. Including you (if you're still standing).

They offer the finest sight-seeing Europe has to offer: the inside of its pubs and bars!

Oktoberfest (Munich), Germany

6.3 million Drinkers. 6.7 million Litres of beer. 1 Mission: to drink your country proud.

Munich's Oktoberfest is the world's biggest beer festival, attracting people from all over the world for a 2-week orgy of partying. With more than a dozen massive beer tents, Oktoberfest is one experience you will never, ever forget.

For the ultra-hard, we recommend a visit to the PigPen in the Hofbräuhaus tent... just don't wear any underwear or bras. (Google it... but you've been warned!).

Maria Alm, Austria

Alpine drinking at its finest! This hidden gem is nestled into the heart of the alps, and some truly unique pubs will be ready for action when you arrive – from the legendary Dengl Alm, where you can order any drink by the meter (yes, a 1-meter rack with 10 full glasses!), to the tiny d'Almhütte'n barely the size of a living room where they hammer out the music and the drinks all night long.

You'll be partying with the locals in true Austrian style – hard!

Prague, Czech Republic

The beer capital of the world, Prague promises you the ultimate in nightlife entertainment with its massive range of pubs, bars and clubs catering for every taste. Our group will attempt to beat some records at the Beer Factory, a unique bar offering its drinkers their own pouring taps on every table – with a huge TV screen projecting each table's performance from hardest to weakest!

Traditional Czech pubs also offer amazing bang-for-buck drinking, with some of the cheapest and best beer and spirits you'll ever have.

Bamberg, Germany

Home to the world's densest concentration of breweries, "Beer City Bamberg" is the ideal pit-stop between Prague and Düsseldorf. The locals here drink an average of 330 Litres (87 Gallons) of beer per person, every year. With dozens of beer gardens just walking distance from your Hotel room, you'll cancel the sightseeing and put all your efforts into pub crawling.

Düsseldorf, Germany

Home of the "World's Longest Bar", Düsseldorf boasts over 360 pubs within its tiny old town square – catering from live-rock music bars to discos, and Irish pubs to breweries.

It's an end-to-end orgy of pub crawling heaven, with hundreds of bars squeezed into a handful of streets, all within staggering distance of each other. It's a smorgasbord of endless partying!

What's included?

- All transportation from Munich through to Düsseldorf (5-star VIP coach bus)
- All entry to pubs and bars, Oktoberfest grounds / tents etc
- Beer tent reservations at Oktoberfest
- 3-star Hotel (4-star in Prague) accommodation or equivalent (twin-share)
- Full breakfast every morning
- VIP Pub Crawl Service:
 - Bilingual Party Guides
 - Exclusive booking of an entire pub in Austria with music on request all night
 - Transportation to pubs / bars each night
- Lots of extras: video production, t-shirts, a traditional Austrian dinner, free Schnapps tasting etc

Things to note

- Accommodation is 3-star (or higher) twin share / double occupancy throughout, single rooms on request at extra cost.
- Transport within mainland Europe is by exclusive 5-star VIP coach bus.
- Travel insurance is compulsory for all our tours, and must cover every country visited.
- Entry visas to some countries may be required depending on your nationality – check with your consulate at least 12 weeks before departure.
- “Euro Hard’n’Fast 2010” is priced **in Euro at €1,990**. Costs will vary in other countries depending on current exchange rate. As of November 2009, they are:

Bus has toilets and fridge on board, and yes drinking is allowed (beer and non-spirit drinks only). Please note European law requires the bus driver to include a 45-minute stop every 4 ½ hours of driving – great opportunity to have lunch and stock up on drinks!

Beer and soft-drinks supplied on bus are €1.50 to €2.00 each.
