Often described as “a kind of German heaven”, Munich boasts some of the most fascinating pubs and bars you’ll ever visit, not to mention a history dating back hundreds of years.

And every year, Munich throws the biggest drinking festival on earth – Oktoberfest! Join 6 million beer drinkers from around the world, as you eat, sing, and drink many 1-litre Steins, while saluting the strains of Bavarian Oom-pah band music.
